Received US citizenship on September 22nd, 1915 in Scranton, Pennsylvania

Residing and working in Detroit, Michigan, as machine operator, “temporarily residing in Łomża, left U.S. on August 4th, 1920, arriving in Warsaw on August 24th, 1920, where I live at the moment until I sell my property”.

Intends to return to US within 12 months or after putting my property matters in order.

American Consulate in Warsaw confirms that no one could identify the person.
