(4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on March 30, 1936 in the Southern District US District Court of Southern District, at New York, NY

we were married on April 8, 1909 at Lodz, Poland; he was born at Wloclaner, Poland on September 10, 1880; entered the United States at New York, NY on May 18, 1909 for permanent residence therein, and now resides at 1166 Grand Concourse, Bronx, NY I have no children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows:

(6) My last foreign residence was Lodz, Poland I emigrated to the United States of America from Bremen, Germany My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, NY under the name of May Anna Kaff alias Andza Ranchmann on May 18, 1909 on the vessel Prinzess Prinzess Alice

(9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since May 18, 1909 and in the County of Bronx this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since May 18, 1909 August 10, 1938 being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition.

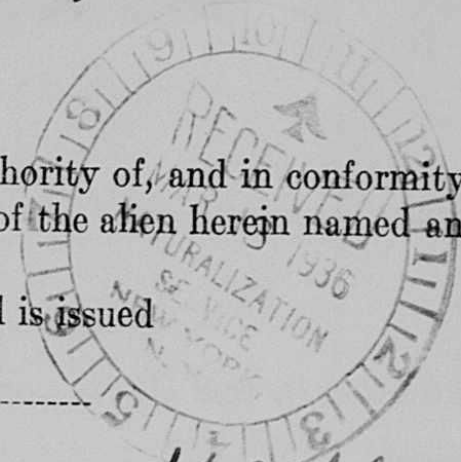
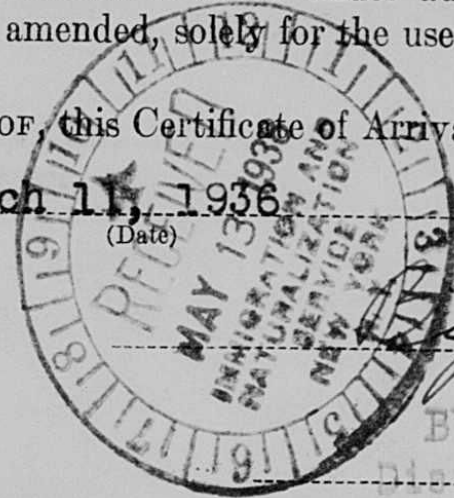

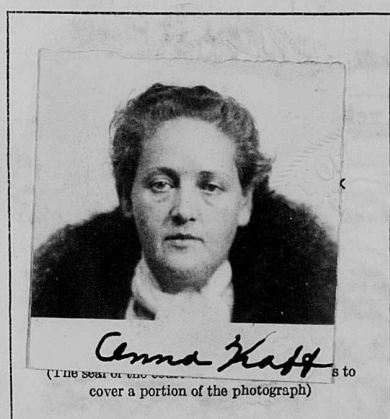
