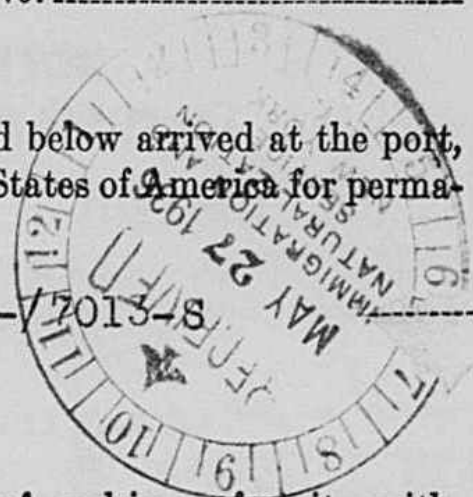

To the Honorable the U.S. District Court of Southern District at New York, N.Y.

The petition of STANLAY KLOSIENSKI, hereby filed, respectfully shows:

(1) My place of residence is 3776 Park Av., Bronx, N.Y. (2) My occupation is Laborer
(3) I was born in Lomza, Poland on November 18, 1893 My race is Polish
(4) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on September 9, 1936 in the U. S. District Court of Southern District at New York, N.Y.
(5) I am married. The name of my wife of XXXXX is Mary we were married on October 19, 1919, New York, N.Y. s.; he was born at Lomza, Poland on April 17, 1898 entered the United States at New York, N.Y. on April 12, 1942 permanent residence therein, and now resides at 3776 Park Av., Bronx, N.Y.; was not naturalized on certificate No. I have 1 children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows: Angelina-Dec. 3, 1920 - Bron and resides at New York, N.Y.

(6) My last foreign residence was Lomza, Poland I emigrated to the United States of America from Antwerp, Belgium My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, N.Y. under the name of Klosiensi, Stanislaw on May 2, 1911, on the vessel SS Finland as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached hereto.

(7) I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. (9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since May 2, 1911

and in the County of Bronx this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since May 2, 1911 being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition.

(10) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization: No. on at and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:

and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed. 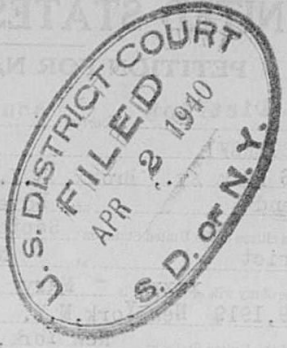
